Approval of Agenda and Last Meeting's Minutes: Given by Shanae Headley. Membership Update: Given by Jenny Hirst. The Hirsts are homeschooling this year and have offered to step down from the positions of Membership and Book Fair. Principal's Report: Given by Mrs. Breeding.

The Safe Weber Plan was released by the Weber School District.

- The plan is intended to be flexible as varying situations in various areas of the District happen.
- The 1st Friday of the school year will be a procedure day to orient the students to the requirements.
- Doors will be open at the school during the school day to allow for air flow. Mrs. Breeding will have doors closed when it is warm outside.
- Face coverings are mandatory, but breaks will be given throughout the day.
- Recess and lunch will be conducted by grade basis.
- Student's will be encouraged to keep wingspan distance.
- Hooper teachers want to be in school and to provide some normalcy for kids.
- Ozone machines will be used if there is a Covid positive case.
- Classroom and possibly the entire grade will go to online learning if there is a Covid positive case within that classroom/grade.
- This plan is directed through the guidance of the Health Department and decisions will be made with that input.
- At the beginning of the year, teachers will assess gaps in their students' learning and gap-filling techniques will be implemented.
- Water fountains will be on, but it is encouraged that students bring their own water bottles.
- The towel dispensers in the bathroom will not be changed out yet. Teach your students air drying.
- If parents need to check-out their student, they should call the school. The office staff will then send out the student. Parents will stay in their car.

<u>Donations</u> will be accepted. The school needs paper towels, kleenex and disinfecting wipes. Please contact the office if you would like to donate money or anything else.

Budget Discussion: Given by Stacy Adams. The proposed budget for the 2020-2021 school year was presented and discussed.

Cindy Pendleton motioned that the 2020-2021 Proposed Budget be approved. Brandi Browning seconded the motion. Vote affirmative. Motion adopted.

Mrs. Breeding submitted a grant form for \$2,080.00 for the purchase of face shields for every student at the school. Added to the grant form at today's meeting includes, face masks, disinfecting/cleaning supplies and classroom/school supplies.

Cassie Brown motioned to approve the PTA grant of \$2080.00 to Hooper Elementary for face shields, PPE, cleaning and classroom supplies. Kelsie Orrock seconded the motion. Vote affirmative. Motion adopted.

PTA fundraising options such as a No Fuss fundraiser and virtual fundraisers were discussed as well. The group consensus was to not do any PTA fundraising until the Spring to give families a reprieve and support the school in their fundraising initiative in the Fall.

Bylaws: Given by Stacy Adams. Hooper PTA Bylaws are set to renew 9-1-2020. The Bylaws were posted to the Hooper Elementary School Website and Facebook on 1 July 2020 for 30 days. There were no amendments made. (Article V Section 3, ...annual membership is valid from July 1 until Oct. 1 of the following school year)

Cassie Brown motioned to approve the renewed Hooper Elementary PTA By-laws. Cindy Pendleton seconded the motion. Vote affirmative. Motion adopted.

- Each appointment is scheduled to last 15 minutes with a five-minute break in between for cleaning and disinfecting.
- The scheduling program has been set up to allow five students to sign up for each appointment slot.
- Exterior doors will be open, to alleviate congestion.

- We will ask that parents and students wear masks and are mindful of social distancing.
- The One-to-One Parent session has been cancelled.
