Old business and approval of last meeting's minutes and agenda: Given by Shanae Headley. The agenda that was posted on the Hooper PTA Facebook page and the Hooper Elementary website on 29 April 2020 was reviewed and adopted. Minutes from the 11 March 2020 meeting were read by Shanae Headley. The meeting scheduled for 8 April 2020 was cancelled. No changes were made and the minutes were adopted as read.

Treasurer's Report: Given by Brandi Browning

- Balance in checking account as of 30 April 2020 is \$14034.43
- Income: Interest \$.71
- Expenditures: Community Involvement \$1406.31 (\$850 Appreciation Gift Cards, \$56.31 Appreciation Signs, End of Year Donation to School \$500), Membership Dues \$20.
- Urban Air finally sent communication (today) that they had finished tallying the money earned for the Urban Air Spirit Night Fundraiser held on January 29th. It totalled \$1546.97. The PTA has still not received this funding, but efforts are being made so that Urban Air can deposit it directly into the account.
- Room moms have until Friday, May 8th to turn in any receipts for reimbursement.

Teacher/Staff Appreciation: Given by Stacy Adams. Gift cards were given to teachers and staff to show the PTA's appreciation. Kelli Brown organized all the room moms to make signs to hang around the fence at the school as well as a solo cup sign in the chain link fence. The PTA donated \$500 to the school to be used to buy t-shirts for the outgoing 6th graders and treats for students at end of the year.

Principal's Report: Given by Stacy Adams.

- Mrs. Breeding will be sending out an email to parents for the last week of school for student pick up of stuff. She said most Teachers are wanting to drop stuff off at students houses and will be contacting parents to set up dates/times. Otherwise there will be days and times (alphabetically time slots) to pick up stuff at the school.
- Back to School night next year will be a little different. They will have sessions for parents to attend in each
 Teacher(s) classroom. It will be like every 30 mins (with bells) from 530-730pm and Teachers will be giving
 instructions/info and parents can go from classroom to classroom between those times. Instead of just a quick
 pop into the classrooms. More communication with parents/students. The date for Back to School night is still
 being decided by the faculty.
- Also thought about having an hour before BTS night starts where kids can go and sign yearbooks from last year. Maybe set up in the Gym with PTA in the Cafeteria or something.

Principal's Report: Given by Mrs. Cummings. She has been blown away with the efforts made for Teacher Appreciation Week. She is so incredibly grateful and thankful for the love, the letters and the emails!





What events, activities and/or fundraisers did you or your child enjoy most this year (or past years)?





Spirit Wear Pre-Pay option




What is the best way for the PTA to communicate with you? (click all that apply)


