**Reflections:** Given by Stacy Adams. At the Fremont Council level we had 2 Award of Excellence and 9 Award of Merit. The Award of Excellence entries have advanced to Region. Council Awards will be distributed next week by Judi Couburn.

**Spirit Wear Orders:** Given by Stacy Adams. The Winter order was submitted, and orders will be delivered after the new year, around January 6th. Parents were informed of the printing delay; however, all orders were still placed. A generous \$200 donation was received so that 20 t-shirts could be given to students who might not be able to purchase their own!

**Book Fair:** Given by Trevor Hirst. The Book Fair scheduled during Parent Teacher Conference in February will be held virtually. Trevor is still creating the event and will give the Board details as soon as possible. Trevor will write an email to contact teachers to choose 2 books to supplement their classrooms to utilize the scholastic dollars that were previously voted on in the March 2020 PTA meeting.

#### Principal's Report: Given by Mrs. Breeding.

- The Couch Tomato fundraiser exceeded expectations! \$8,000 was raised for i-touch screens in 3 classrooms!
- Hooper Elementary had its first student positive COVID case. Affected 5<sup>th</sup> grade parents were notified on Monday and 14 students were quarantined because the 5<sup>th</sup> grade was in block schedule. Since contact tracing works well, the whole 5<sup>th</sup> grade did not have to quarantine. Students were issued Chromebooks to alleviate schoolwork at home.
- If students want to take advantage of the Free Breakfast option, they must arrive at school by 8:15 am.
- Mrs. Breeding has begun research on getting an electronic marquee. This is a quite an expensive purchase (around \$18,000). The possibility of a Weber Foundation Grant next year for \$5000 could perhaps be used towards this purchase. Mrs. Breeding is not asking for PTA funds at this time, but to possibly partner with a fundraising opportunity next year. If anyone has any contacts or even information on a community sponsor, please reach out to Mrs. Breeding or the PTA.

## Principal's Report: Given by Mrs. Cummings.

- Thank you for the Twisted Sugar cookies! They were so yummy!!
- The teachers have been asking about the Teacher Team Grants that have been traditionally offered during this time of year. Due to school needs for supplies and masks, the original amount that was budgeted to Classroom Grants was used, per a general membership vote at the August PTA meeting. Discussion was had regarding moving funds from Community Involvement (which is the largest expense category) to General & Administrative to ensure that these Teacher Team Grants could still be provided this year.

Shanae Headley motioned that the General and Administrative budget line item be amended to add \$2000 from the Community Involvement budget line item for Classroom Grants. Cindy Pendleton seconded the motion. Vote affirmative. Motion adopted.
